NIGHT RATING TRAINING

A Night Rating (NR) allows the holder of a PPL(H), CPL(H) or Airline Transport Pilots License (ATPL(H)) to exercise his/her privileges during legal nighttime. Night flying opportunities in South Africa are mostly limited to areas with city lights, however many pilots enjoy the flexibility to be able to extend their day trips to land just after night fall. The training represents a fascinating introduction to instrument flying techniques and a re-cap of the dangers of flying in low visibility. A NR is a highly recommended upgrade to a PPL(H) and essential for a CPL(H) or ATPL(H) license.

Pass Requirements for your Night Rating:

A pass mark of at least 75% is required for all your examinations. Total of 1 examination is required.

The South African minimum requirements for your Night Rating are:

- 18 Years or older
- PPL(H) (and is part of your CPL(H) training)
- Fluent in English (Speak, read, write, and understand) and pass the English Proficiency Examination
- A Class I or II Aviation Medical
- We will assist you with booking your Aviation Medical appointment

Flight Hours:

approx. 15hours

- 10 hours of instrument instruction of which no more than 5 hours are allowed to be accumulated on a simulator.
- Approximately 5 hours night flight training, which includes a cross country flight and simulated emergencies.
- A night cross-country flight of at least 75 nautical miles including two landings at two different controlled airports.
- Practical flight test.

Ground School Subjects:

- Pass the SACAA online exam.
- Complete 5 hours of Ground School.
