

Our World-Class Licence Training:

AIRLINE TRANSPORT PILOT LICENCE(H) ATPL(H)

This course is highly recommended for those individuals wishing to enter the corporate flying world. This is the highest certification level a helicopter pilot can achieve. The ATPL Course is designed to give the student the aeronautical skill and experience necessary to meet the requirements of the ATP certificate and operate safely as an airline transport pilot.

NOTE: this is essentially not a course offering, but more guidance towards ATPL. HAFS can assist a student when there are short comings to completing your ATPL when you near 1500hours total time)

The South African minimum requirements for an ATPL(H) are:

- 21 years old
- A Class I or II Aviation Medical.
- We will assist you with booking your Aviation Medical appointment.
- Hold a valid CPL(H)
- The Night Rating
- The Instrument Rating
- The Multi Engine Rating
- The Commercial theoretical ground school and examinations
- Hour building
- Have completed the appropriate training at an authorized ATO
- Fluent in English (Speak, read, write, and understand) and pass the English Proficiency Examination

Pass Requirements for our ATPL(H):

A pass mark of at least 75% is required for all your examinations. Total of 6 examinations are required.

Ground School Subjects: 40 hours

After completing the below and your final flight test, which will be a multi-engine instrument flight test, you will be issued an Airline Transport Pilots License (H).

- Aviation Meteorology
- Aircraft Technical and General
- Radio Aids
- Instruments
- Navigation
- Flight Planning and Performance

Flight Hours:

- A minimum of 1500 hours in total of which:
- 250 hours minimum as pilot in command
- 50 hours minimum as pilot in command by night
- · 200 hours minimum as cross country
- You require a minimum of 30 hours instrument flight time of which 10 hours may be accumulated on a simulator
