### PRIVATE PILOTS LICENCE HELICOPTER (PPL(H))

A PPL(H) qualifies a pilot to fly without remuneration. A Helicopter Private Pilot License gives the holder the privileges necessary to fly a helicopter recreationally or build time towards a Commercial Pilot License Helicopter (CPL(H)). It represents an enjoyable, yet challenging learning curve that will culminate in the ability to fly your family and friends in a helicopter safely. Helicopter pilot training at Henley Air Flight School is one of the best experiences a young student pilot can experience!

#### Pass Requirements for your Private Pilot License Helicopter (PPL(H)):

A pass mark of at least 75% is required for all your examinations. Total of 8 examinations are required.

#### The South African minimum requirements for PPL(H) training are:

- 16 years of age, to go solo.
- 17 years of age, to obtain your PPL.
- Fluent in English (Speak, read, write, and understand) and pass the English Proficiency Examination
- A Class I or II Aviation Medical.
  - We will assist you with booking your Aviation Medical appointment

#### Flight Hours:

Minimum 50 hours flying time, of which 5 can be completed in our B222 FNPT-II simulator.

#### Ground School Subjects:

approx. 40hours
