Pass Requirements for your Multi-Crew Co-Operation Training:

There are no examinations required for this type of training.

The South African minimum requirements for Multi-Crew Co-Operation Training are:

- 18 Years or older
- PPL(H) or CPL(H) or ATPL(H)
- Multi-Engine Rating, or obtain your MER while doing the MCC with us
- Fluent in English (Speak, read, write, and understand) and pass the English Proficiency Examination
- · A Class I or II Aviation Medical.
